### OVERVIEW

- Attendance for programs is going well across the board
  - o Summer Reading Program had over 40 kids sign up, Trivia Night at the brewery has consistently had over 40 participants, and our last teen game night had double the usual amount of participants
- The library has been routinely updating our policies. All policies containing information relevant to patrons will be available on our website

### UPDATES

- Computers have been ordered for the children's room
  - o We are also in the process of updating our security software which will completely wipe patron computers every day as well as securely blocking access to restricted sites
- Our 3D Printer is essentially up and running now
  - o There is currently a link on our website homepage to a 3D Printer "How to print" guide
  - o Classes are planned for teaching the basics and more advanced operations for any patrons interested in learning
- Our county briefly rose into the High-Risk category for COVID, but is currently at Medium
  - o I will continue monitoring CDC risk assessments and guidance and am prepared to implement safety measures if necessary

### TECHNOLOGY

- The HVAC system has had a noticeable decline in operation, even though the control panel claims everything is running normally
  - o A tech from Garrhs is scheduled to come by on August 2 to service our equipment and present options for the immediate future
- We've also discovered that another contributor to our high electricity bills is our solar panels are malfunctioning
  - o Our solar panels have just been serviced and are now functioning
