### OVERVIEW

- May 26 from 5:30 – 8:00, the library held an Open House event to highlight the various programs, events, and items the library has to offer
  - o This event featured food, live music, a scavenger hunt for kids and prizes
- Our senior worker, Dearle Ricker, has been reassigned by SER to work at the Montezuma Heritage Museum and we wish her the best
- In June, we'll be receiving some furniture (2 small armchairs) donated by the Telluride library
  - o At this time, it'll be placed in the children's room since our number one request is for more adult seating there
- We are preparing for Summer Reading with a schedule of various activities and events for children, teens, and adults that follow this year's theme of All Together Now
  - o Normal library programs will happen as normal with the exception of our Friday Children's program

### UPDATES

- The Little Free Library's base has been completed and it is now mounted in the outdoor area
  - o A group of volunteers dug the hole for the base and another volunteer group is planned to paint / stain the library
  - o A plastic rocking chair has also been purchased and secured near the Little Free Library for outdoor reading
- During the review of our emergency plans, the children's room was determined to be the most problematic area due to lack of emergency exit
  - o We've replaced the closet doorknob that leads to the staff area with a smart doorknob that can be opened in an emergency
  - o We're also looking into the possibility of converting one of the children's room windows into an emergency window exit
- The HVAC project will most likely be pushed to next year
